Canadians — a light, tight fusion band with trumpet and a selection of singers — draw attention through sensitive playing and interesting arrangements to

some of the joys in the Lennon canon that we might have forgotten. I Am The Walrus shouldn't work as a sinuous groover but it sounds just fine, Instant Karma! has a taut Indie swing, while even Working Class Hero turns out plausible, partly because it's sung by Elizabeth Shepherd and so further distanced from the male-voiced original, partly because Occhipinti gives it jungle percussion and a Fender Rhodes stoked chug. Girl also gets a fresh rhythmic twist. The real stand-outs are the most beguiling melodies: I'm Only Sleeping, which trips along quickly with a jazz waltz rhythm on the verse, and Across The Universe with its dreamy guitar mix of sustain, chorus and harmonics. The final masterstroke is leaving out that dull, overplayed drone called Imagine. **PB**
